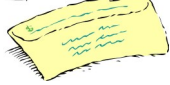

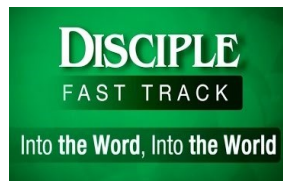

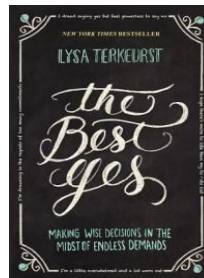


Opportunities for Adults Short-Term Faith Studies

*We will conclude our study on Acts on Wednesday, January 8.



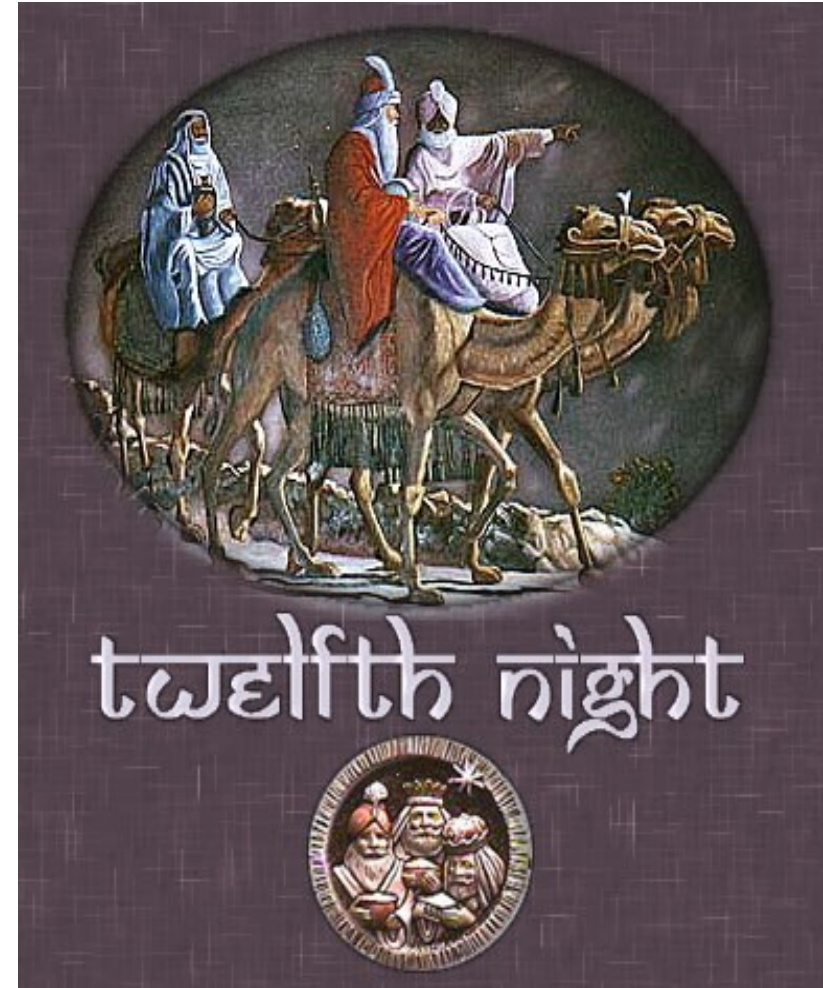
