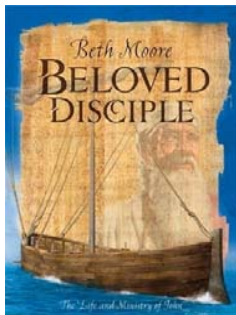

Carillion Choir Rehearsal will resume on Wednesday, January 16 at 6:15 in the Handbell Room 211. New ringers are welcomed!

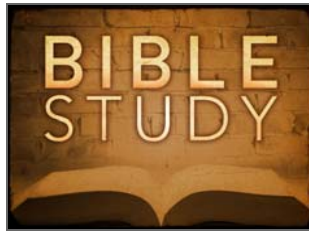
