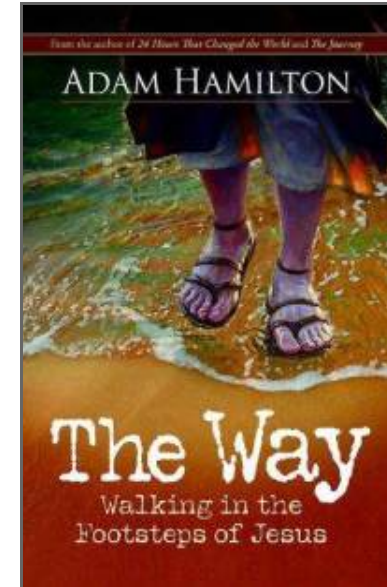

Paint By Number

Do you remember the old paint by number sets you did as a child? Every space marked by a “1” you painted green; “2” you painted red and so on until a beautiful image emerged. Every February, United Methodist Churches are asked to paint by numbers. Our year-end statistical reporting is not the favorite activity of church staffs but through this process – a picture of God at work in and through the church begins to emerge. Here are a few highlights:

- ◆ God blessed us with growth in 2012 increasing our membership by 25 persons to 880 at year end.
- ◆ Twelve persons made professions of faith as followers of Jesus Christ.
- ◆ More than 50 children and youth actively participate in the life of our fellowship.
- ◆ Our average worship attendance was 236 with a 13% increase over 2011.
- ◆ We support over 25 ministries for mercy, justice, and outreach like CAP (Churches Assisting People), The Shepherd’s Table, Help4Kids, Operation Christmas Child just to name a few. These ministries serve a conservative estimate of 16,091 people!
- ◆ We supported our United Methodist missionaries, crisis relief through UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) and other UM ministries through the \$30,014 apportionment we gave to this support.
- ◆ Additionally we supported both United Methodist as well as local missions through your generosity of \$15,935.

I celebrate that these are just a few examples that begin to reveal the beautiful picture of how God is at work among us here at First Church. I praise God from whom these blessings have flowed and await with eager expectation how God will use us even more in 2013. *Reverend Kyle*
