We tried to sort this out a bit on Wednesday evening (the handouts are available on the YTTB table) and will continue to address it as we read the prophets. *The books of the prophets in the Old Testament spoke first to specific historical and theological situations, and then their voices have been heard through the ages.* So pay attention now and you'll have a head start this summer!

I thank God for the blessings of our YTTB, and the good ways it is stirring within our church. And remember, God loves you; and so do I!
