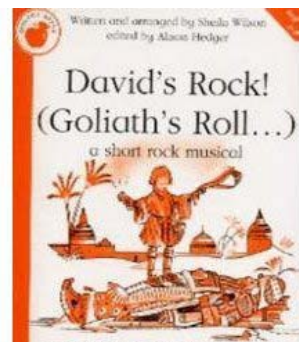
## Spring Choral Concert: Monday, April 23 at 7:30 p.m.
