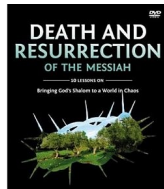

# First View

## Epworth Mothers



### Jennie Capers

Jennie came to Epworth in 1905 after the death of her husband. Mrs. Capers was the "Mother" of boys in the Coleman home where she remained until her death in 1934.



### Charlotte Todd

Charlotte came to Epworth in 1918 as a little girl with her sister Henrietta after their parents died during the flu epidemic of 1918. She graduated from Epworth Orphanage High School in 1926 and Columbia College in 1930. She then returned to Epworth as a matron. Miss Todd was the "Mother" of the new boys in a home where she remained until her retirement in 1977.



### Marjorie Holley

Marjorie came to Epworth in 1947 after graduating from Asbury Methodist College. She had thought of being a missionary, but noticing her caring personality, a Methodist minister at Asbury suggested Epworth. Miss Holley's mission - being the "Mother" in the little boys home. She retired in 1990.



### Edith Caldwell

Edith came to Epworth in 1969 as the new dietitian after working at North Greenville Baptist College. Miss Caldwell was arguably the hardest working "Mother" at Epworth. She cooked and cleaned three times daily for up to as many as 200 children during her 27 years at Epworth. She retired in 1996.



### Mary Parsons

Mary came to Epworth in 1997 to work in operations. Providing transportation for Epworth children to off campus appointments and activities is what she enjoyed most, the direct interactions with the children. Mary is now the Family Care Center Educator, where she provides support for the children and their families. Most importantly, Mary is providing love as an Epworth "Mother".
