Flowers are needed in June and July.

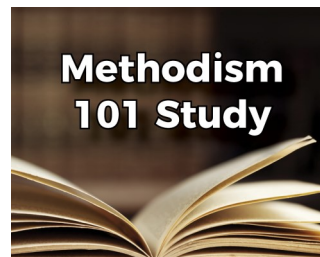
