The Prophets

This week we begin reading the final section of the Old Testament. You may have noticed that in the Hebrew Scriptures the Prophets are the second section, but in Christian scriptures they come last in our Old Testament. There, they serve as a natural and inspirational bridge from the promises of God to Israel to the fulfillment that comes in Christ Jesus.

As we read the books of the Prophets, we will regularly recall their setting in the faith history of Israel and consider where they are fulfilled in the person of Jesus as the promised Messiah. Later this summer, when we begin reading the New Testament together; we will notice how frequently the Old Testament verses are quoted directly and are referred to indirectly. Just in the four gospels, we will recognize nearly 100 direct Old Testament quotations - many of them from the books of the Prophets.

To assist our understanding of these important (but sometimes overlooked) books, we will have regular visits from some of the Prophets during our Sunday morning worship services. Thus, we will be able to remember and "tie up" our journey through the Old Testament and be much better prepared to gain insight and guidance from the New.

It looks like we have an exciting and inspirational summer before us! And remember, God loves you; and so do I!
