"Catching Fire"

"Catching Fire" is a program and challenge that is being developed by the Discipleship Committee to increase attendance in the Sunday School Classrooms at First Methodist. The committee recorded attendance for each classroom in the first quarter of 2012 and divided the sum by 13 weeks in order to arrive at a mean attendance score for each classroom. For example, the Hut Class averaged or had a mean score of 24. Their challenge is to have more than 24 in attendance each week beginning the first week in July 2012 and ending November 11th. For every person over 24, the Hut receives 1 point and we will keep their attendance score in the common area near the parlor. We will keep the attendance score for the Nursery, High School as well as all the other Sunday School Classrooms in the church posted each Sunday so every member can see which classes are exceeding their attendance averages. If the challenge is successful, awards will be given on November 18 during Sunday School.
