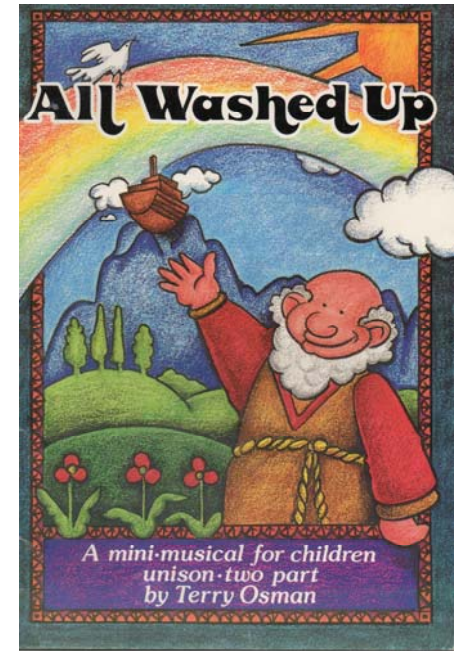

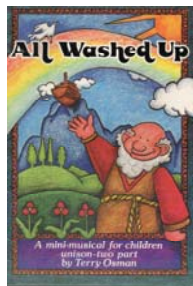

Budget Information Explanation

By now, most of you have seen the budget information included in each week's bulletin regarding "Receipts to Date" and "Needs to Date", all as a part of our Brown Bag Catch-Up Special. Just so you'll more fully appreciate the urgency of this mid-year budget push, "Receipts to Date" is the actual amount of giving that the church has received since January 1, 2011. "Needs to Date" is a figure made up of two parts: What we as a church have actually spent so far this year AND a total of all bills/accounts payable that are currently due. As a result, when the bulletin shows a deficit of approximately \$50,000.00, for example, that actually means that we are that far behind in our giving at that particular time. In other words, that figure is a REAL DEFICIT and NOT just one based on what our projected receipts and expenditures might be IF we want to meet our budget. Please join your church family in praying about your response to this need and then follow God's call as you continue to return to Him a portion of what He has entrusted to you. Thank You.
