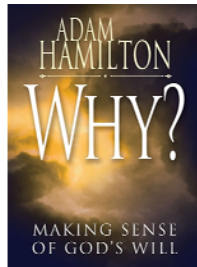
Join us in Sunday School and Worship as we put God first in living and giving during the month of October!
