## An Historical Glimpse into Our Past

**1785-1815** Methodist Bishop Francis Asbury's many visits to Kingston (Conway) preceded the organization of a Methodist congregation in Conway.

**1828** A Methodist group began meeting in the home of Mrs. Jane Norman.

**1842** The land on the corner of Fifth Avenue and Main Street was given to the Methodist Church.

**1844-45** The first church building was constructed on the site of the current Hut Bible Class building.

**1898** The original church building was dismantled and replaced by a second sanctuary.

**1910** The third mission-style sanctuary was constructed.

**1938** An educational building was added to the rear of the mission-style sanctuary.

**1952** An addition was made to the west side of the educational building.

**1961** The present Georgian-style sanctuary and educational building addition were completed.

**1999** The Family Life Center was consecrated on November 14, 1999.
