Instead of collecting individual Thanksgiving items, CAP asks that each church sponsor 50 families @ \$25 each which will provide a full Thanksgiving meal kit

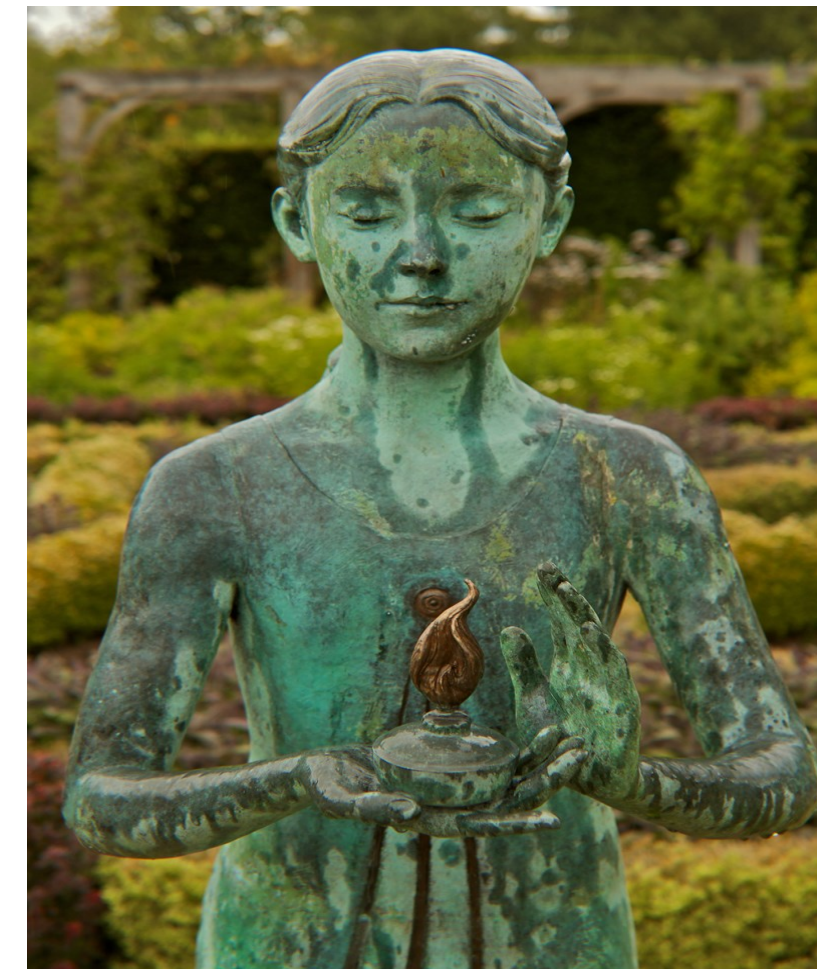
