Pedro Update: Pedro is growing, eating, and is fully transitioning into his new home with Tim, Julie, Mason and Molly in Auburn. He continues to make regular visits with a team of specialists who are caring for him and helping to plot the next steps in his journey. He recently spent 3 days at the Children's Hospital in Birmingham for observation and testing in addition to returning to Greenville Shriners' Hospital for follow-up. His future steps include...

- † Cleft-Palate reconstruction
- † Observation of Right Eye
- † Continued monitoring for the eventual fitting of prosthetics
- † Monitoring of Hydrocephalus and seizure medication
- † Medical Visa extension

These are only a part of the surgical process. He is continuing to be evaluated in ways to help him grow and develop. Tim and Julie have begun the process of adoption. 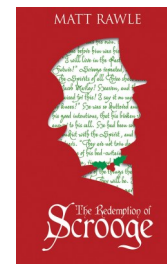

Who: All Children ages 2 to 5

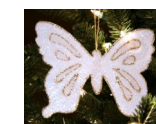
What: Being Thankful Story Time and Play Date
