## THE LIGHTING OF THE CONGREGATIONAL CANDLES

As the acolytes pass the light to members of the congregation, pass it to  
the person next to you. DO NOT TIP a lighted candle. While the light is  
being passed, the Minister reads the following:

\* LESSON OF LIGHT      John 1:1-14

*In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and  
the Word was God. <sup>2</sup>He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup>All things  
came into being through him, and without him not one thing came  
into being. What has come into being <sup>4</sup>in him was life, and the life  
was the light of all people. <sup>5</sup>The light shines in the darkness, and  
the darkness did not overcome it. <sup>6</sup>There was a man sent from*

*God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup>He came as a witness to testify to the  
light, so that all might believe through him. <sup>8</sup>He himself was not  
the light, but he came to testify to the light. <sup>9</sup>The true light, which  
enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. <sup>10</sup>He was in the  
world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world  
did not know him. <sup>11</sup>He came to what was his own, and his own  
people did not accept him. <sup>12</sup>But to all who received him, who be-  
lieved in his name, he gave power to become children of God,  
<sup>13</sup>who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the  
will of man, but of God. <sup>14</sup>And the Word became flesh and lived  
among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's  
only son, full of grace and truth.*
